

FITZROY PAINTING: BEGINNERS LEVEL 3

PLEASE READ ALL NOTES BELOW SO YOU ARRIVE PREPARED FOR YOUR CLASS.

Materials:

Students are expected to have their own painting materials and apron. Our Level 1 kit contains the basic materials required, and can be purchased directly from the studio, either online when booking, or on arrival, just let us know ahead of time.

In addition, the following **oil colours** are required:

- Yellow Ochre
- Spectrum Crimson (or any Series 1 Crimson)
- Raw Umber
- Carbon Black (or Lamp Black or Mars Black)
- Green Earth
- Lead White (optional)

Brushes: Should be synthetic (no bristle), a couple of size 3 - 4 rounds, along with your regular brushes. **A soft mini mop brush for blending is also essential.**

Medium: Low toxic, low odour oil painting medium (small bottle). We recommend Langridge or Gamblin Galkyd Lite.

Paper: Pre-toned oil sketch paper to work on will be provided.

Images: Please bring a choice of **at least two HIGH-RESOLUTION images** of your choice to work from. These should be A4 or A3, depending on the size you wish to paint. One copy is to be black and white on standard copy paper, the other to be printed on heavier-weight photo paper. It is recommended that you get them printed at Officeworks or similar to have a good quality image to work from.
